Dear Nancy Hammond,

She's pregnant. She's alone. And she's scared. What will she do?

She can only think of one option — abortion.

However, she cannot visualize the actual procedure because she never really thought about it. She has no idea how much her unborn baby is developing inside her womb. She only knows what she's heard — abortion seems like her only option. And ... even though something inside her spirit doesn't feel right about having an abortion, she convinces herself that it must be safe because, after all, it's legal. Since approximately 3,700 abortions are performed in the United States each day, she assumes it's an acceptable option to her situation.

The above scenario is very real. In fact, thousands of women every day choose abortion because they don't know what else to do. But what if these women knew there was a place they could go to get accurate information where no one would pass judgment on them for the decisions they've made? Thankfully, and because of support from people like you, these women in crisis can come to the AAA Crisis Pregnancy Center for love, support, and the facts.

When women in crisis walk through our doors, they are given accurate information about fetal development and abortion procedures, including the risks. Our lay counselors are available daily to share the truth through the love of Christ. As God leads, we present each client with the gospel of Jesus Christ.

When women leave the Center, we want them to walk out feeling empowered by the information they've received, comforted by the fact that they've met someone who truly cares and confident in knowing that they are welcome to return.

**This year, we have experienced more than 1,300 client visits at AAA Crisis Pregnancy Center—an increase of 44% over last year!**

- More than 400 women visited for the first time and were in need of pregnancy tests
- Greater than 750 women were helped with material goods for their babies through the Center's material goods incentive program

God's ministry at AAA Crisis Pregnancy Center is to share the love and gospel of Jesus Christ, while reaching out to those in need.

As you are aware, one of the many services offered to our communities through this ministry is TASK, Teaching Abstinence Save Kids. With this program, we reach into local schools to teach God's truth to the youth and their parents. We're excited about the growth this program has seen in the last 12 months.

New this year is a support group for mothers of pregnant teens. As you can imagine, there has been a great need for this and, thankfully, God has opened the doors to help us meet this need.

Post abortion counseling at the Center is growing more than we originally anticipated. In 2006, we offered three sessions instead of two.

As you can see by the increasing number of people that are being helped at the Center, the need for financial support has grown. But unfortunately, giving has not grown along with the demand for our services. Now, more than ever, the women and families that depend on the services offered through the Center are in need of your help.


